Village Farms Drainage Concerns

Village Farms Education Foundation

- No change since the last report. The resident survey for the Village Farms Education Foundation feasibility is awaiting resident distribution by the director of technology since our October board meeting
- Doug to withdraw from leading this effort

Clubhouse Flag Installation

- In an effort to continue improvements to the clubhouse grounds and social branding of Village Farms, it is recommended the board approve the installation of a flagpole at the entrance to the clubhouse as budgeted for the 2021-2022 association year. A quote for a 25' tall aluminum and illuminated flagpole with external rigging and a 4' X 6' U.S. flag has been received for \$3,467. A second quote has been received for a 25' tall pole with interior rigging (theft proof) and a 5' X 8' US flag for \$4,473. The second quote is being recommended due to:
 - The exterior rigging (halyard) system is theft proof as all adjustments are made through a locked door.
 - o Lifetime shaft warranty; one year parts warranty.
 - The company is local and provides repair service if needed.
- A motion for approval of the recommended quote is sought.- Motion carries
- Location will be outside the entrance of clubhouse where it meets the circle
- Not recommended by vendor to fly a Village Farms flag in addition to the American flag due to the increased weight

Village Farms Resident Memorial

- Upon the death of our fellow board member, Tom Fredrickson, the homeowner's
 association memorialized his dedicated service to the Village Farms community with
 a permanent bench located on the Oak Ridge Road dam. Recognizing the possible
 desire of family and friends to similarly memorialize departed Village Farms
 residents, the following proposal is submitted for the boards consideration to be
 further discussed and voted upon at the March meeting:
 - Association owned common ground property locations should be identified at lake or walking path locations throughout the community suitable for the installation of a

- bench and/or covered swing each installed on a concrete pad. Each bench or swing would include a brass plaque with an appropriate dedication message.
- The memorial would be individually approved by the board and be completely funded by the party requesting the memorial bench or swing. The exact final cost of the bench or swing would be determined at the time of the request. At this time, the expected cost of an installed bench is approximately \$800-1,000; a swing is \$1,500-2,000.
- Ownership of the bench or swing would be given to the Village Farms homeowner's association by the requesting party. The association would then be responsible for its upkeep and maintenance.
- o The installation of the bench or swing would be completed by an outside contractor.
- An appropriate article recognizing the memorial opportunity would be included in each Village Farms newsletter.
- The benefits of this proposal to Village Farms are:
 - Family and friends have an opportunity to provide a long-lasting memorial to a departed Village Farms resident.
 - There is no initial cost incurred by the homeowner's association.
 - The memorial provides lakeside and walkway seating for Village Farms residents.
 - The addition of swings and benches add value to the Village Farms community.
- The costs of this proposal to Village Farms are:
 - The additional future upkeep and maintenance costs of the benches and swings. This could be limited time-wise in the agreement with the donor.
 - The possible increased cost of property insurance for the benches and swings.
- Photographs of a similar type of proposed bench and swing have been included with the distribution of this board report
